### Informed Consent and Ownership

A main goal of the UNEP/RAIPON project “Capacity building for the Integration of the Indigenous Peoples Traditional Knowledge into Disaster Management and Biodiversity Conservation in the Russian Territories of Nenets Autonomous Region and Kamchatka” is to make indigenous knowledge on natural disasters and their management available and useful to a wide audience.

The RAIPON training sessions held in each region stressed this goal and stressed the importance of conveying this to the people being interviewed, and the importance of obtaining prior consent for interview results being made available publicly. Interviewers subsequently discussed the project with each person interested in being interviewed and obtained their verbal consent for publishing the results of interviews. Anonymity is and will be preserved in all public documents and presentations, unless the interviewee consents to be recognized by name.

The transcripts of interviews and the lists of names of people interviewed are owned by RAIPON on behalf of the interviewees. The synthesized results from this project are jointly owned by RAIPON and UNEP and all uses of this material require approval from both organizations.
